**For the safety of all clients, visitors, contractors and staff, we require everyone to complete a screen for signs, symptoms and risk factors associated with COVID-19 before entry to our building.**

1.	Have you travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days?		
2.	Have you tested positive for COVID-19 or had close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 without wearing appropriate PPE?		
3.	Has a doctor, health care provider, or public health unit told you that you should currently be isolating (staying at home)?		
4.	Do you have any of the following new or worsening symptoms?	YES	NO

**Results of Screening Questions:**

If answers are NO to all questions from 1 through 5, you have PASSED and can:

- 1) report to work (Pathways staff)
- 2) enter the Centre
- 3) receive in person services.

If answers are YES to any question from 1 through 5, you have NOT PASSED and cannot

- 1) report to work (Pathways staff)
- 2) enter the Centre
- 3) receive in person services.

Public Health Ontario recommends that anyone exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, or failing the screening questions, not be allowed to enter Pathways or receive in-person services. Go home to self-isolate immediately. Staff should contact Human Resources and their immediate supervisor.
