I am going to Pathways to have my ears checked.



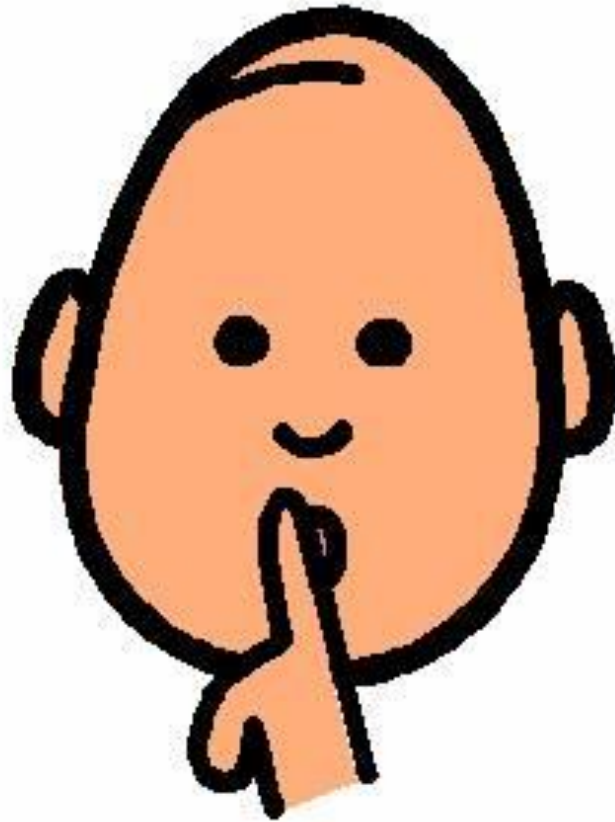
At Pathways, I will meet Dana or Charlene. They are going to check my ears.

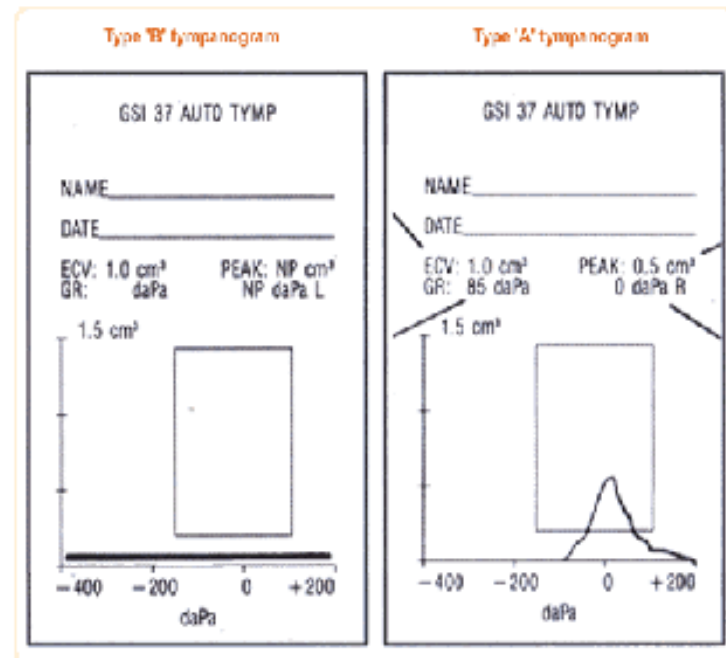


First, they will look into my ears with a funny looking flashlight called an otoscope.



Next, they will gently put earplugs in my ears and I will hear some beeps.

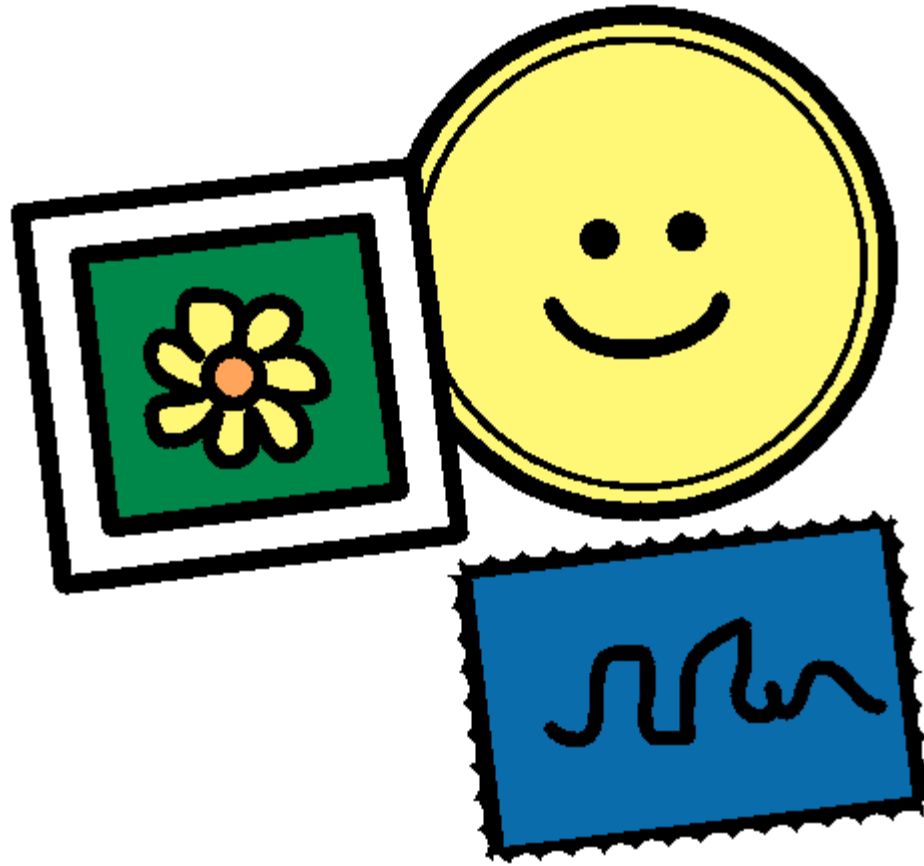




When the beeps are all done, the machine will draw a picture. The picture will be a mountain or a box.
