Pathways Health Centre for Children is a family-centred community agency serving children and youth with physical, developmental and communication needs and their families as well as adults for selected specialized services in Lambton County. The Centre provides a full range of family-centred rehabilitation and support services. Aquatic programs in our therapeutic pool are open to people of all ages and abilities in the community. There is also an integrated childcare service (C.A.C.H.É.) on site.

Community Support Workers

Key Responsibilities:

Family & Transition Support Workers support Pathways' clients in their homes or within activities outside the home implementing goals and objectives determined by the family and the Family & Transition Supports Supervisor. Hours worked in this position can be any time during the week. Staff may be required to travel throughout Lambton County, (Sarnia as well as Petrolia, Alvinston, Forest, Port Lambton).

Qualifications:

- Recent and relevant post-secondary education or training within a child or youth related discipline or focus preferred
- Previous experience working with children or youth with diverse needs including physical, developmental and/or behaviour challenges
- Enthusiastic about working with children/youth, adults and their caregivers

Skills / Abilities:

- Self-motivated, strong organizational and written communication skills
- Proven ability to work independently and as a team member
- Proven problem-solving abilities

Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age
- Access to reliable transportation and availability to work flexible hours
- Demonstrated health and physical condition consistent with lifting and transferring clients in a safe and appropriate manner in various environments (e.g., floor, mats, stairs, pool, etc.)
- Vulnerable Sector Police Check required within the last 6 months
- Health Statement and up-to-date Immunization Record (e.g., tetanus must be within the last 10 years)
- Bilingual communication skills an asset
- Current CPR/First Aid
