Therapeutic Pool – Changeroom Project

November 15, 2022

Pathways Health Centre for Children is excited to announce the commencement of its Phase 2 refurbishment work in the therapeutic pool area. Phase 1, accomplished in 2021, saw a complete rebuild of the pool, pool deck and mechanical room. Phase 2 of the pool refurbishment will see extensive renovations and accessibility improvements, including modifications to changeroom stalls and spaces, showers, new lockers, wider doorways, new tile work and flooring and hands-free fixtures. The project also includes an additional HVAC unit and installation of UV filtration units.

To meet required timelines, the contractors are set to begin this month! While our intent is to minimize disruption in services, this undertaking will have an impact on our pool programming:

- As of November 21, 2022, users will experience some shifts in changeroom facilities to accommodate the launch of the project.
- As of December 11, 2022, it is anticipated that the pool will need to close and remain closed for a significant portion of the project timeline (December 11, 2022 March 31, 2023). For programs scheduled December 12 December 23, 2022 please note that a credit will be applied to your account.

If we are able to reopen at any time during the project, we will communicate through our website and Facebook sites.

This Phase 2 work will see completion of the pool project, envisioned to refurbish the entire aquatics area to state of the art facilities, reviving the pool that was initially opened in 1986. This investment will ensure that Pathways Health Centre for Children's irreplaceable community asset will be available to serve the Sarnia-Lambton community for many years to come.

While we are most excited about what this project will deliver for our community, we do apologize for this short-term inconvenience.
