Special Needs Camps offer trained staff to help eliminate the barriers that your child may face if attending a mainstream camp. These camps will offer one to one or smaller group settings to ensure that your child is receiving the support needed. This will allow them to participate in a meaningful way and enjoy the summer camp experience with their peers. Here are some Special Needs Camps located in and around the Sarnia-Lambton area.



YMCA Inclusion Camp is available for children with special needs and/or disabilities that are eligible and require assistance to successfully participate in all camp programming. Inclusion support is facilitated by our friendly inclusion counsellors (youth with at least one year of camp experience) and is offered at all day camp locations!

Mainstream camps can work for your child, depending on your child's ability. To see if a camp will be a good fit, here are some steps to help ensure a successful camp selection:

• Contact the camp in advance to book an appointment to meet with the coordinator and staff to discuss your child's needs and if there are additional staff that could help support your child.

• Create a biography page about your child. Include what makes them special, helpful hints on how you support your child. This helps better inform the staff on what makes your child special and also is a document that they can refer back to if needed.

• Please know that majority of camp counselors are either high school or college students with no previous experience work with children who have special needs. Please be open and honest to ensure a successful camp experience for your child. 


LAMBTON COLLEGE SUMMER CAMPS


