Pathways Health Centre for Children is a family-centred community agency serving children and youth with physical, developmental and communication needs and their families as well as adults for selected specialized services in Lambton County. The Centre provides a full range of family-centred rehabilitation and support services. Aquatic programs in our therapeutic pool are open to people of all ages and abilities in the community. There is also an integrated childcare service (C.A.C.H.É.) on site.

Entrance to School CHILD CARE ASSISTANT (up to 35 hrs per week)

The successful candidate will assist the classroom teachers with planning and implementing learning experiences that advance the cognitive, emotional, social and physical development of children within a safe, healthy learning environment and promote inclusion.

QUALIFICATIONS, KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS:

- Area of study in Autism and Behavior Sciences, Early Childhood Education, Developmental Service Worker, Child and Youth Worker, or related field
- Current Standard First Aid/CPR certification
- Strong organizational, interpersonal and communication skills
- Ability to work as part of an interdisciplinary team
- Ability to physically assist children with participation in program activities
- Understanding and acceptance of differences in children's learning behaviour
- Understanding and acceptance of differences in children on the Autism Spectrum
- Self-motivated
- A Police Vulnerable Sector Check is required

This position is available through funding from Canada Summer Jobs (The Government of Canada) and as such applicants must meet all the following criteria to be eligible:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the start of employment;
- be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*; and
- be legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial / territorial legislation and regulations

*International students are not eligible.

SALARY: \$16.55/hour
