Pathways Health Centre for Children is a family-centred community agency serving children and youth with physical, developmental and communication needs and their families as well as adults for selected specialized services in Lambton County. The Centre provides a full range of family-centred rehabilitation and support services. Aquatic programs in our therapeutic pool are open to people of all ages and abilities in the community. There is also an integrated childcare service (C.A.C.H.É.) on site.

Information Technology (IT) Technician

The successful candidate will be responsible for the provision of for monitoring, maintaining and assisting with various day to day IT related issues as well as project work related to the HRIS platform.

- Hardware and Software Updates and Maintenance Approved by the Network Administrator
- Maintain and Update Intranet/Website as Required
- Corporate Services Support

QUALIFICATIONS, KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS:

- Post-secondary education in Information Technology is required
- Must possess strong verbal and written communication skills, be well-organized, and have the ability to maintain accuracy in a detailed environment
- Knowledge of Active Directory, MS Exchange Server, Citrix, WIFI Management, and TCP/IP Network Protocol an asset
- Integrity to work with highly confidential personnel information
- Available to work flexible hours including evening and weekend work as necessary
- Valid Ontario Driver's License and adequate liability insurance or have ongoing access to a vehicle and driver, must be able to provide own transportation to special events
- A Police Vulnerable Sector Check is required

This position is available through funding from Canada Summer Jobs (The Government of Canada) and as such applicants must meet all the following criteria to be eligible:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the start of employment;
- be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*; and
- be legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial / territorial legislation and regulations
