



Pathways Health Centre for Children, Sarnia

Pathways Health Centre for Children is a family-centred community agency serving children and youth with physical, developmental and communication needs and their families as well as adults for selected specialized services in Lambton County. The Centre provides a full range of family-centred rehabilitation and support services. Aquatic programs in our therapeutic pool are open to people of all ages and abilities in the community. There is also an integrated childcare service (C.A.C.H.É.) on site.

We are currently recruiting for the following position to join our team of professionals as an:

Support Facilitator (2 Full Time Permanent)

Working under the direction of the Supervisor of Community Services, Support Facilitators provide support to the program staff of a community childcare setting to respond to the diverse needs of all the children. Ability to work independently and collaboratively with other team members while under clinical guidance and direction of a Resource Consultant including but not limited to:

- work collaboratively with a team at a community child care centre
- encourage opportunities for the program staff to interact with the child with special needs
- communicate with the staff, family and other professionals involved regarding the child's daily activities
- provide direct support to assist a child in their participation in the child care programming
- initiating and assisting with inclusive activities within the structure of the community child care setting
- adhere to policies and procedures defined by the community child care setting

** Hours worked in this position could be any time between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. (7-hour shifts), Monday to Friday, throughout Lambton County.

QUALIFICATIONS, KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS:

- Recent and relevant post-secondary education or training within a child or youth related discipline or focus preferred
- Ability to lift and move children and equipment as required
- Experience working with children with special needs (preferred)
- Experience with Indigenous and diverse communities an asset
- Cultural Competency training is an asset
- Fluency in French an asset

The successful candidate must be available to work flexible hours. The successful candidate will be required to provide personal transportation to and from child care centres throughout Lambton County. A valid Ontario Driver's License with access to a reliable vehicle and proof of current insurance is required. Mileage will be paid in accordance with Pathways Health Centre for Children current Transportation policy. A Vulnerable Sector Police Check is also required at time of hire (dated within the last 6 months) as well as proof of immunization including COVID-19 vaccination.
