Pathways Health Centre for Children is a family-centred community agency serving children and youth with physical, developmental and communication needs and their families as well as adults for selected specialized services in Lambton County. The Centre provides a full range of family-centred rehabilitation and support services. Aquatic programs in our therapeutic pool are open to people of all ages and abilities in the community. There is also an integrated childcare service (C.A.C.H.É.) on site.

We are currently recruiting for a **Child Care Assistant, C.A.C.H.É. Child Care Service (Casual)**

Reporting to the Supervisor, C.A.C.H.É., the Child Care Assistant will assist classroom Early Childhood Education (ECE) teachers with planning and implementing learning experiences that advance the cognitive, emotional, social and physical development of children within a safe, healthy learning environment and promote school readiness.

Qualifications, Knowledge and Skills:

- Diploma in a related field to Early Childhood Education an asset
- Current Standard First Aid/CPR certification required
- Strong organizational, interpersonal and communication skills
- Ability to work as part of an interdisciplinary team
- Comfortable interacting with children with special needs as well as typically developing children
- Ability to physically assist children with participation in program activities
- Understanding and acceptance of differences in children's learning behaviour
- Ability to follow directions and provide input to the team re: classroom and individual child programming
- Competent computer and documentation skills
- Understanding of How Does Learning Happen? Pedagogy and the importance of making meaningful connections with children and families
- Commitment to a routine-based child care approach
- Fluency in French an asset
- COVID-19 vaccination

The successful candidate must be available to work flexible hours, a Police Vulnerable Sector Check is required as well as at least two doses of the COVID-19 vaccination.
