Soon, I will go to Pathways.



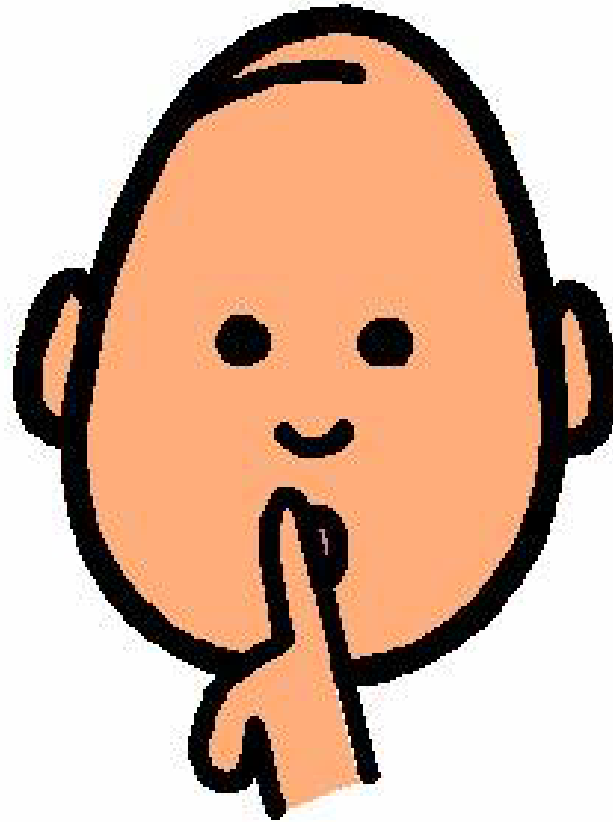
At Pathways, I will meet Jenny or Charlene. They are going to check my ears.

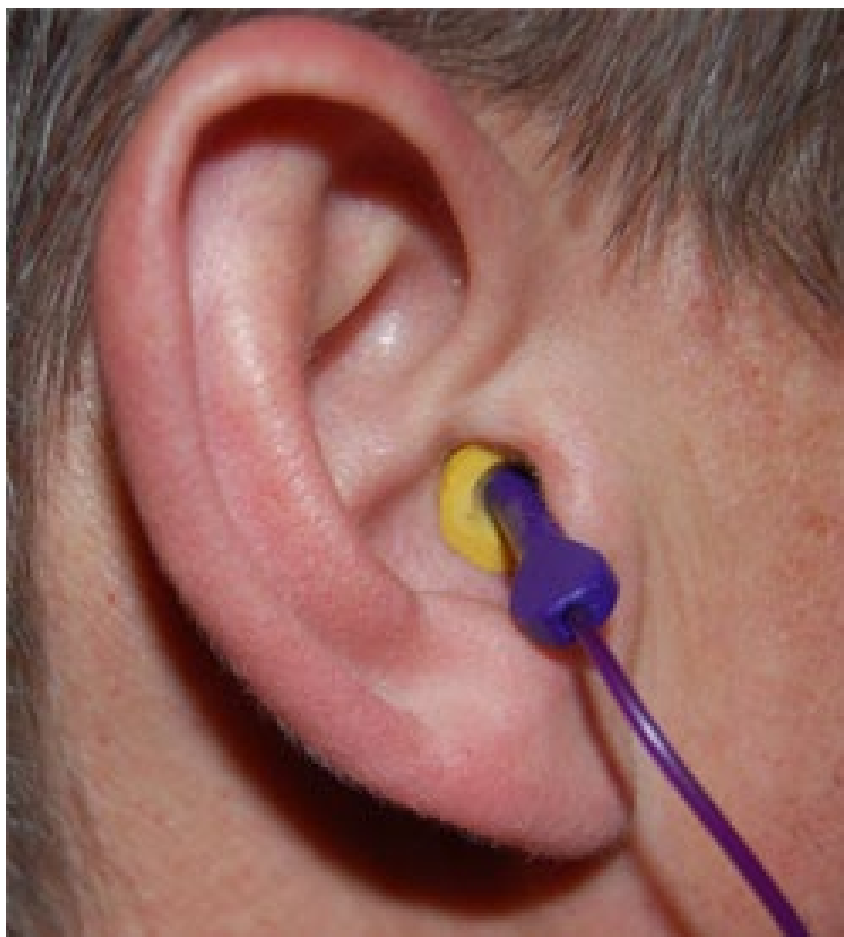
When Charlene or Jenny call my name, it will be my turn. They will take me to a special room where they can check my ears.



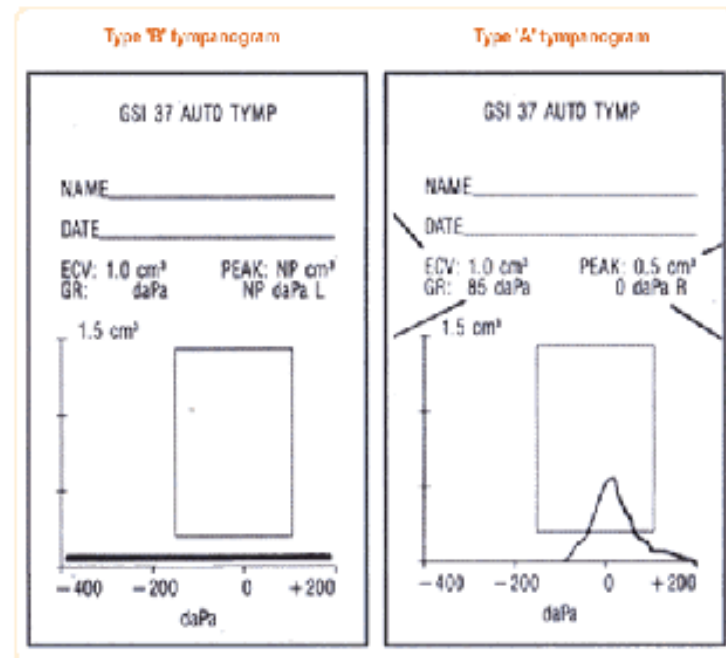
It is important to stay very quiet when I get my ears checked. I will be ok! She might have to touch my hair or my ears, but she will be very careful. I can take a break if I need to.



First, she will look into my ears with a funny looking flashlight called an otoscope.



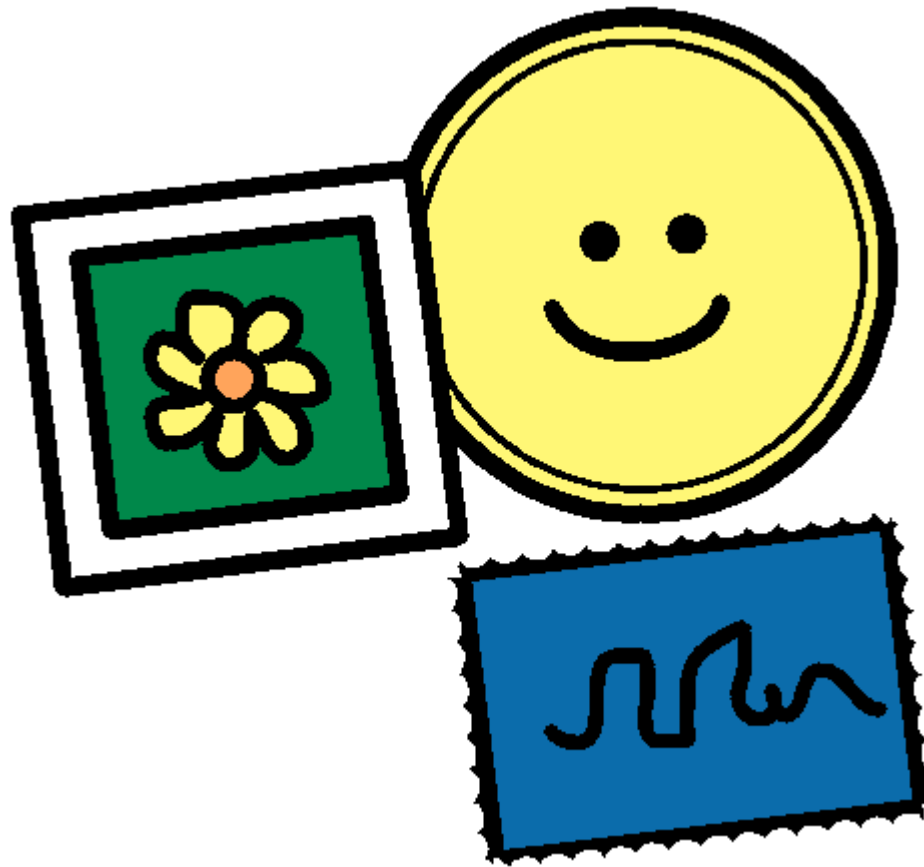
Next, she will gently put earplugs in my ears and I will hear some beeps.
